The idea of perfection is one that is hammered into our heads from an early stage. On the ballfield you will hear coaches exhort that "perfect practice makes perfect." When a student takes a test in school, they strive to achieve a perfect score, indicating their knowledge and understanding of the concepts at hand. Yet the idea of perfection in the Bible does not always carry this meaning. Sometimes, when we come upon the word perfect, we can take it to mean complete as Paul does in 1st Corinthians 13:10 speaking of the fullness of God's revelation.

The Greek word teleios, which is used in our text and translated into English as "perfect" often carries the understanding of completion, and not necessarily flawless. In this context, I believe that to be the better understanding of the word. Here, Jesus is preaching one of, if not the, greatest sermon ever preached and he is discussing the notion of having love for everyone, and not simply those who love you. If we are to understand perfection here as being complete, then we must recognize that our love for others must be complete in the same way that God's love for man is complete.

Luke, recording the words of Peter in the book of Acts, writes that "God does not show favoritism but accepts from every nation the one who fears Him and does what is right" (Acts 10:34-35). If we are to be perfect in the way that Jesus prescribes in our text, then our love for mankind cannot have any partiality. We must love those who break the rules, who speak negatively of us, who live immoral lives in the same way that we love our closest friends, family and confidants. This is not a suggestion, or merely a good piece of advice, but something that Christ demands. You *must* live this way, if you wish to reflect Jesus in the way our Lord demands. Andrew Beasley
