The superscription for Psalm 57 identifies the text as being a psalm of David when he was hiding from Saul in a cave. Which cave is being referenced is impossible to know as it may be the cave at Adullam (1<sup>st</sup> Sam. 22) or En Gedi (1<sup>st</sup> Sam. 24). More important is the reason for David's presence in the cave. He was alone, hiding from a man who wanted to kill him, and entirely helpless. Here he turns to God and seeks refuge in Him, and then ends his prayer repeating the words "Be exalted, o God!" from earlier in the psalm.

Without being too hard on David, I find many similarities between him and modern-day followers of God. Often, we are guilty of waiting to exalt God. We wait to put him in a position of power and authority over our lives, until we find ourselves in a tough spot. In modern times countless things have taken priority above God in many peoples lives until a serious need arises where we no longer feel like we can handle things on our own. How shameful. We have turned sports, television, shopping, theater, and countless other things into idols and elevated them above the one who, through His great grace, has made eternal salvation available to us.

One may ask how Christians might end this sad pattern and the answer is found in the concluding words of this psalm. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens! Let your glory be over all the earth! This must be our attitude! We must return God to the rightful place he belongs in our lives. Exalted far above everything else.
