Some estimates claim that there are nearly 3,000 shipwrecks off the coast of the Outer Banks. Museums and visitors centers in the area place heavy emphasis on the notorious pirate Blackbeard and his crew. When one thinks of pirates, they often think of treasure maps, gilded chests and shiny gold coins. Movies have been made, such as Pirates of the Caribbean, that glamorize piracy and the hunt for buried treasure at one location or another. I can't speak to how many pirates happened to find the x that marked the spot on their treasure map, but I do know of a treasure far greater than anything we might find buried on an island in the Atlantic.

Charles Spurgeon, noted Baptist preacher who lived during the 19th century, wrote a series of books titled "The Treasury of David" that focused on the Psalms. Anyone who has ever read through the book of Psalms knows how valuable the words penned within are. Paul refers to the Gospel as being the "unsearchable riches of Christ" (Eph. 3:8), meaning that there was no bottom to the depth and the value of what there is to learn and know about Christ and the Gospel.

Into our hands the Gospel has been given. Into our hands is given the light. We don't need a map with an x on it. You can find it in any library, in any app store, and access it seemingly anywhere in the world. Paul, in writing to Timothy, says that all scripture is profitable (2 Tim. 3:15-16). Those words are more than accurate because within the text of the treasure trove that is the Bible, we learn how to lay up treasures for ourselves in heaven (Matt. 6:19-21) and how to prepare for the return of the Lord who one day will come to take us home (John 14:3).
