Have you ever wondered why there are so many types of churches in the world today? One study done by the Center for Global Christianity estimates that there are 200 Christian denominations in the United States and 45,000 globally. Yet Paul, through inspiration, explains that there is one body, one spirit, one Lord, one faith, one baptism and one God and Father of all (Eph. 4:4) to explain the oneness of the church and the things that bind us together. There cannot both be one united body, and 45,000 denominations who often contradict one another in both doctrine and practice.

This is an issue which the church at Northwest has attempted to address in some way this weekend. Our focus has not been about showing why other groups of worshippers are wrong, but about learning how we might ensure that the assembled group of people at Northwest are functioning as the church of God's intent. Attention has been given to the conclusion of the second chapter of Acts, after Peter establishes the Lord's church on Pentecost.

This morning, Mike Glenn from the North Carolina School of Biblical Studies will speak to us during our Bible Class hour regarding the commonality of the church. During our hour of worship, Dr. Scott Gleaves from Faulkner University will address the subject of the sacrificial nature of the church. It is my prayer that by giving consideration to these two speakers today, and the five lessons from Saturday, that we will be strengthened in our understanding of who God wants us to be, and how God wants us to act, that we might better be able to function as the church God intends for us to be.
