Not long before she died in 1988, in a moment of surprising candor in television, Marghanita Laski, one of the worlds best-known secular humanists and novelists, said, “What I envy most about you Christians is your forgiveness; I have nobody to forgive me.” What a heartbreaking statement regarding how she viewed herself and those around her, but what a triumphant proclamation about the power of Christian forgiveness when it is done properly.

There are few things that sum up the love of God more than the forgiveness that he bestows upon His faithful followers. While it is certainly necessary for Christians to follow suit if we wish to be pleasing to Him (Matt. 6:14-15) and that can be challenging enough at times, the truth is that the hardest person for us to forgive is the person staring back at us in the mirror. In fact, it is one of the common reasons that people refuse to follow Christ. Unable to forgive the person looking back at them in the mirror, many find it impossible to believe that God could do so.

It is imperative for us to understand the greatness of God, and to not limit what God is capable of. In doing so we enable ourselves not only to forgive others for their wrongs against us, but to forgive ourselves as well. Because of His great love, and His great capacity to forgive, we are able to apply His greatness to our own lives and live as a reflection of God’s forgiveness and love, and to show it to others in our lives.
