Recently there has been a post circulating on social media that goes something like "I often wonder what I would do if I knew that today was going to be my last day on Earth, and then I remember that Jesus knew, and He washed feet."

There are certainly lessons to be taken from these thoughts, and from the opening events of John 13. Our Savior was aware of the biggest trial that awaited Him and yet he served those closest to Him in several ways. First, He showed by example the way that His disciples would need to approach the world, through service. Among the early church there would be opportunity for each of them, and other significant individuals, to be exalted to a degree that was dangerous (1 Cor. 1:12). Second, He showed them through teaching how all should be viewed equally (Jn. 13:16). Lastly, he shows them through His command the character trait that would make it possible for them to achieve this, a trait that Paul would later call the "greatest of these", love (Jn. 13:35).

Jesus, the Servant Savior, showed how it was that even the Son of God could bend down and wash the feet of His disciples. Then, through example, teaching, and commandment showed His disciples first, and shows us today, how we can, and must, do the same regardless of what manner of trial or tribulation might be present in our lives.
