How long, Lord? It is a question that is frequently asked in Scripture. The Psalmist asks God how long He will hide his face in Psalm 13. Habakkuk opens his writing asking God how long He will allow corruption and violence to continue. John, in Revelation 6, records the voices of the martyrs crying out and asking how long it would be until God would avenge their blood. In all three instances trouble has come by the hand of others.

The second chapter of Proverbs highlights a contrast between those who are righteous, and those who choose to live otherwise. Solomon's advice to his son is that if he lives a life that follows a path of righteousness, then he will be delivered from those who choose to walk paths that are crooked. For the modern reader, we should recognize that this principle holds true today. If we walk righteous paths, then we will be delivered from those who do evil, who walk paths that are crooked and evil. In doing so He will walk with us and will deliver us.

Yet, we should be aware that the deliverance God promises may not come in this physical life, but at the end of our physical life when we receiver our eternal inheritance. Regardless, He walks with us even through the valley of the shadow of death, and even when those who walk contrary to His will assail us. Thanks be to God for this great truth.
