A man was once asked what the difference was between ignorance and apathy. His response? I don't know and I don't care. It is a funny little play on words, and while there is humor in the statement the Christian must recognize that there is great danger, especially in apathy. One can read the story of the Ethiopian Eunuch in Acts 8 and find evidence of a man who, to some degree, was ignorant. He was trying, studying the Scripture, but still was aware that he did not know, or understand, the things that he was reading. His solution? Allow someone who did know, that being Phillip, to show him.

In the story of the Ethiopian eunuch, we find a man who does not know, but thankfully not a man who does not care. For both the first century and modern-day church, apathy was and is a fatal condition. For some, worship has become an obligation instead of a privilege. Fellowship has become an option, rather than a necessity. Studying God's word has become an inconvenience, rather than a blessing.

Our generations are not the first to experience this. We find evidence of apathy and indifference even in the first century at the church at Laodicea. They were a church who were, apparently, going through the motions to the extent that Christ calls them "lukewarm" and says he will "spit you out of my mouth" (Rev. 4:16). Yet Christ did not leave them without a solution. Be zealous, and repent. Light the fire and change the way you have been thinking and acting. That puts the impetus on us. If we are apathetic, we must be the ones to reignite the fire within us. How do we do that? By placing God in the proper position of preeminence in our lives.
