One of the fascinating stories from the Old Testament comes from the twelfth chapter of the book of Judges. There, Gileadites had captured fords of the Jordan against the Ephraimites. When one of the fugitives from Ephraim would try and cross the river, the men of Gilead would ask if he an Ephraimite. If he said no, the Gileadites would then ask him to speak the word Shibboleth. For whatever reason the Ephraimites were unable to pronounce the word properly, and he would be captured and killed.

There are many lessons that can be taken from the judges, including the brief history we are given about Jepthah and his conflict with the Ephraimites. The one that I want us to focus on this morning is how our speech identifies us. In the US if you hear someone use the word "yinz" you can expect they are from Western Pennsylvania and more narrowly, Pittsburgh. You can tell if someone is a native of Louisville, Kentucky by the way they pronounce the name of the city.

Keeping with that theme, when a person goes out into the world and claims to be a Christian, the world will take notice of how you carry yourself and how you speak. James reminds us of the dangers of the untamed tongue. He says "How great a forest is set ablaze by such a small fire! And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness" (James 3:5-6). In Bible class we often sing to our children "be careful little mouths what you say."

Oh that we would be the same, that when we call ourselves Christians the world does not hear us try to say "Shibboleth" and identify ourselves as not being who we claim to be.
