When one lands in Costa Rica the first thing that you notice is the heat, but what you notice after that is how friendly the people of Costa Rica are. A random stranger can wander their streets, stopping at each house shouting “HOLA, BUENOS!” and if someone is home, they will come out to have a conversation with you, even if it is just for a few minutes. In many cases their generosity shines through as they open their home to you, cook for you and serve you in whatever way they can. It is an environment ripe for sharing the Gospel.

This is different from the United States where in many cases if you were to knock on someone’s door while they are home you would be greeted with a harsh word if the door was answered at all. Yet I am convinced that one of the greatest failings of the church in the United States is Christian’s unwillingness to talk about their faith outside of the church building. We might have said “Hola, Buenos!” to 1,000 people over the course of 7 days. Collectively the group had bible studies with 20 people, had 6 visitors come to our meetings (all six came for multiple evenings), had 1 request for prayer and 1 baptism.

This is what 6 individuals were able to accomplish over the course of 7 days of evangelism. Imagine what a church of 70 could do if we simple asked people if they would like to study the Bible with us when we conversed with them throughout the day. If we went out into our world and strove to make disciples (Matt. 28:18-20). How much could we accomplish? My guess is more than we could possibly imagine.
