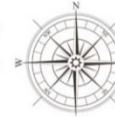

Agape: More than Just a Word

How do Christians express the kind of love Jesus Himself demonstrated? He was quite clear that emulating this kind of love is central to our lives as Christians. In fact, Jesus said that learning to love like Jesus is to embrace a kind of love that can encapsulate the entirety of Old Testament teaching (Mark 12:28-31). Clearly, the “agape” kind of love must be more than just a word.

One of the ways modern Christians can express this kind of love is demonstrated in the great work of Agape of NC. It is our honor this morning to welcome and learn from Joe Hall.
