Elmer and the Six Million Dollar Man

Elmer McCurdy was born on January 1, 1880 to a single mother in Maine. His life was short and violent, being fatally shot by law enforcement following an Oklahoma train robbery when he was only 31 (his take was a whopping \$46 and the conductor's watch). But it is what happened to Elmer's body that really made him famous. After being embalmed and put on display in a local funeral home, his mummified remains were paraded around the country where people paid to see the body of "The Outlaw Who Wouldn't Be Taken Alive" (jmarkpowell.com).

Over the years Elmer's body began to be mistaken for a mannequin and went from owner to owner. In 1976, during the filming of an episode of "Six Million Dollar Man" in a fun house, what was believed to be a wax figure was finally discovered to be the remains of Elmer McCurdy. In 1977, 66 years after his death, Elmer's body was laid to rest in Guthrie, Oklahoma's "Boot Hill," next to outlaw Bill Doolin.

While few of us can hope of having as adventure packed "afterlife" here on this mortal globe, we can choose to live each day of our current life for Christ, thereby preparing for an eternal afterlife with God. In other words, how we choose to walk now will determine where we will walk eternally. So, let's put Jesus on in baptism and then walk with Him daily. Jesus WANTS to walk with you through life, so he calls us through the gospel to "Come to Me... and I will give you rest ... For My yoke is easy and My burden is light" (Matthew 11:28-30).
