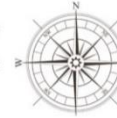

What have you done for me lately? That's the question that is often posited regarding workplace performance, athletic performance and just generally what one might be contributing to society. Christianity, to a certain degree, is a what have you done for me lately religion. James says that faith without works is dead (James 2:20). Just two verses later in discussing Abraham and Isaac, James asks "do you see that faith was working together with his (Abraham) works, and by works faith was made perfect" (James 2:22). It has never been God's intention for His followers to simply sit back and enjoy the wonderful bounty that is afforded to those who belong to Him.

The faith "hall of fame" chapter of Hebrews 11 illustrates that truth wonderfully. Abel, Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Sarah, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, the Israelites, Rahab, the judges and the prophets are all described as having a faith that lead them to action. Simply believing in God was not enough, they were expected to head His call for their lives and follow His instructions. It is no different for the Christian today. Our faith cannot be a surface level faith that does not transform or motivate us. A significant portion of the Gospel of John is dedicated to expressing the fact that a faith that does not lead us to do more, and be more, is not the sort of faith that saves.

We cannot simply believe. Even the demons do this (James 2:19). Rather, our faith must be the transformative sort that leads us out of self service and into His service, spreading the Gospel and bearing good fruits day by day. So, what has your faith done for Him lately?
