Have you ever considered that the difference between living a Christ-centered life and a self-centered life is frequently love, or a lack of it? Paul, after enumerating the miraculous gifts that some in the early church were blessed with, notes that one could speak in the tongues of angels and men but if love is absent then all that was being accomplished was a lot of noise being made. Like a clanging cymbal or a resounding gong (1st Cor. 13:1). This should not surprise us as Jesus says the two greatest commands are to love God first and others, both friends and enemies alike, second.

You have probably heard it said that there are four words in the ancient Greek language that are translated into the singular English word "love." The love that Jesus speaks of in answering the question regarding the greatest command, and the word that Paul uses for love in 1st Corinthians 13, is agape. Agape love is not a brotherly love, a familial love, or an erotic love. It is a love of choice, a love of purpose and a love that is not shaken in good times and bad.

Is that the love that you have for God? Is it the love that you have for your neighbor? Is it a love that both desires, and seeks, what is best? If we are to bear the fruit of the spirit (Gal. 5:22-23), then we will embody this manner of love and the world will be able to see it, and partake of it, in our lives as the fruit of the spirit grows on the spiritual branches of our life.
