

GOD MEETS HUMANITY IN THE PERSON OF JESUS


THE WORD IS ETERNALLY PREEXISTENT - 1 IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD,

- "IN THE BEGINNING..." REMINDS US OF THE FIRST WORDS OF GENESIS
 - GENESIS 1:1
- BEFORE CREATION, JESUS, THE WORD, IS ETERNALLY EXISTENT
 - Colossians 1:17
 - THE STORY OF INCARNATION AND REDEMPTION IN THE SON OF GOD IS AS ETERNAL AS GOD
 - SALVATION BY MEANS OF A SUFFERING SAVIOR IS NOT A REACTION TO THE MISFORTUNE OF SIN
- THE WORD WAS NEVER CREATED
 - He is the "I Am"
 - EXODUS 3:13–14
 - JOHN 8:58

- JOHN USES THE GREEK "LOGOS" TRANSLATED "WORD"
 - THE SENSE OF LOGOS IS THAT OF **COMMUNICATION**
 - GOD DESIRES TO REVEAL HIMSELF
 - God's communication to men and women is Jesus, the eternal Son of God
 - 2 CORINTHIANS 8:9
 - PHILIPPIANS 2:5–11

THE WORD IS IN ETERNAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE FATHER - "AND THE WORD WAS WITH GOD,"

- "WITH" LITERALLY MEANS THE WORD WAS TOWARD GOD
- THE FATHER AND THE SON ARE IN ETERNAL CONNECTION
 - 1 JOHN 1:2
- THE WORD IN NO WAY OR AT NO TIME DISPLACES THE FATHER
- The relationship of the Father and the Son, by implication shows equality and intimacy in the Trinity God being the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit exists eternally



THE WORD IS ETERNALLY GOD - "AND THE WORD WAS GOD."

- THE WORD IS BOLDLY AND CLEARLY DEITY
- Jesus always exists as God, living in fellowship with God the Father,
 and by implication, in fellowship God the Spirit
- The Church was quick to codify the understanding that Jesus is God
 - ROMANS <u>9:5</u>
 - Hebrews 1:8–9

THE WORD IS ETERNALLY CONNECTED WITH THE FUNCTION AND PURPOSE OF GOD — "HE WAS IN THE BEGINNING WITH GOD."

- This verse is a restatement of what John said in the previous verses
- JOHN WANTS TO DRIVE THE POINT HOME
- The Word is eternal and the Word is in constant harmony and fellowship with the Father
- THIS IS A POINT JOHN WILL CONTINUE TO MAKE
 - JOHN 5:18

THE WORD IS THE CREATOR GOD (1:3)

- ³ ALL THINGS WERE MADE THROUGH HIM, AND WITHOUT HIM WAS NOT ANY THING MADE THAT WAS MADE.
- EVERYTHING THAT EXISTS OWES ITS EXISTENCE TO THE WORD
 - PSALM 33:6
- NO MEMBER OF THE GODHEAD ACTED ALONE AT THE TIME OF CREATION
 - 1 Corinthians 8:6
- JOHN WANTS US TO KNOW THAT JESUS WAS ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN CREATION AND HIS CREATIVE MAJESTY IS TO BE HONORED
- OTHER NEW TESTAMENT WRITERS HONOR THE CREATIVE POWER OF JESUS AS WELL
 - Colossians 1:16–17
 - HEBREWS 1:2–3
- It is important to understand that as the Creator of all things, He cannot be created

THE WORD IS THE LIFE AND LIGHT OF GOD (1:4-5)

- 4 IN HIM WAS LIFE, AND THE LIFE WAS THE LIGHT OF MEN.
- JOHN'S POINT HERE IS THAT JESUS IS THE GIVER OF SPIRITUAL LIFE AND LIGHT
- WE ARE MEANT TO BE ENCOURAGED WITH THE KNOWLEDGE THAT JESUS BRINGS LIGHT TO A
 DARKENED WORLD AND TO DARKENED HEARTS
 - LIFE AND LIGHT ARE NO LONGER PART OF THE NATURAL ORDER OF PEOPLE BECAUSE OF SIN
 - Spiritual life and light are supernatural gifts brought by the Creator for the blessing and benefit of His people in need
- THROUGH THE COMMUNICATION OF TRUTH THROUGH JESUS, THERE IS VIVIFICATION AND ILLUMINATION
 - JOHN 3:3
 - JOHN 8:12

THE WORD IS THE LIFE AND LIGHT OF GOD (1:4-5)

- ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.
- THE FUNCTION OF LIGHT IS TO REMOVE DARKNESS
- SINFUL PEOPLE ARE NOT NATURALLY DRAWN TO THE LIGHT, BUT ARE REPELLED AND REPULSED BY THE LIGHT
 - JOHN 3:19-21
- THE WORD WHO SHINES WITH GOSPEL GLORY, IS NOT PASSIVE AND DISTANT
 - JESUS REVEALS TO SINFUL MEN AND WOMEN THE LIGHT OF HOPE AND SALVATION FROM THE DARKNESS OF SIN
 - Hebrews 7:25
 - The darkness of sin is no match for the light of help and hope that shines through the gospel of Jesus
