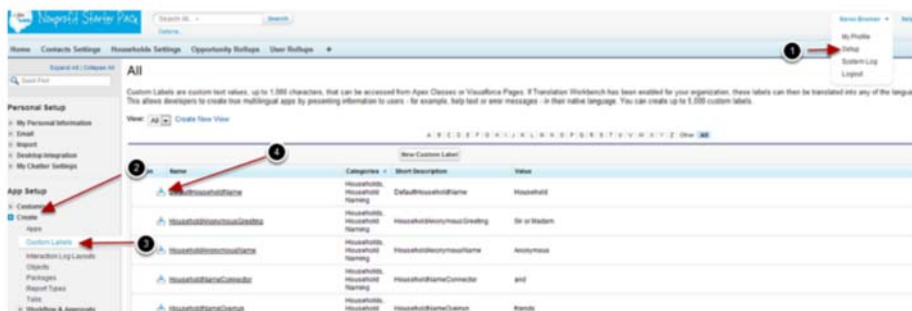

## NPSP: Editing Custom Labels

Although you cannot directly edit Custom Labels that are part of a managed package, you can 'translate' them, even into the same language. This article will show you how to modify the Custom Labels in the Nonprofit Starter Pack

### About Custom Labels

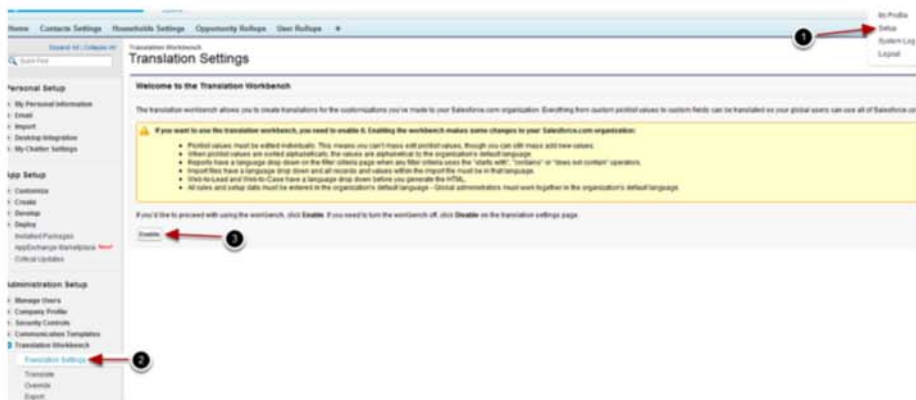


Custom Labels allow user to translate and modify textual information in the Nonprofit Starter Pack that is accessed in the code as well. They provide integral functionality for various parts of the Starter Pack, including help text, currency symbols, and much more. You can find Custom Labels by going to:

1. Setup
2. Create
3. Custom Labels

You can see which Custom Labels are part of Nonprofit Starter Pack (or other managed packages) by noting the symbol with the blue arrow to the left of the label name. (4)

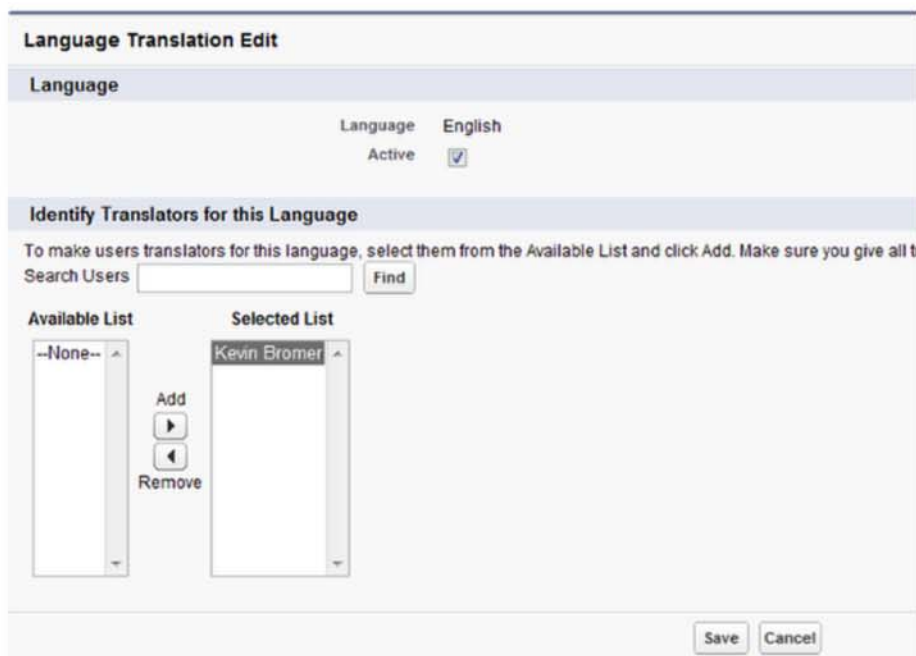
### Turning on the Translation Workbench



In order to edit Custom Labels that are part of a managed package, you'll need to turn on the Translation Workbench. You can do this by going to:

1. Setup
2. Translation Settings
3. Clicking 'Enable'

## Enable English (or your preferred language) Translations



Once the Workbench is enabled, you'll need to add English as an available language if not already visible. You can do this by click on 'Add', then selecting English. You'll also need to add the name of the user who will be responsible for the translations. Click 'Save' when complete
