

HOW TO PRAY FOR YOUR CHILDREN

Sunday

Pray they will ask Jesus into their lives early on (Psalm 63:1; 2 Timothy 3:15).

Monday

Pray they would be caught when they break the rules and that their shortcomings would draw them closer to Jesus (Psalm 119:71).

Pray they would be protected from Satan in every area of life: spiritual, emotional, physical (Luke 2:52).

Tuesday

Pray they will be responsible in their interpersonal relationships (Daniel 6:3).

Pray they will respect those in authority over them (Romans 13:1).

Wednesday

Pray they will be wise in choosing their friends (Proverbs 1:10-11).

Pray they will wait to date and be wise with who they entrust with their hearts. (2 Corinthians 6:14-17).

Thursday

Pray they will fight for purity in their dating relationships (2 Corinthians 6:18-20).

Pray that in all circumstances they will know the right thing to do and have the courage to do it (James 4:7).

Friday

Pray they will serve Jesus wholeheartedly (Romans 12:1-2).

Pray for God's protection on their lives, so they would not be drawn to people or places that would take their attention off the perfect plan He has for them (Hosea 2:6).

Saturday

Pray their children and grandchildren will give their lives to Jesus and serve Him with their whole heart, soul, mind and strength (Matthew 22:37-38).

Pray that, when they leave home, they would see the world as Jesus does and make decisions based on the truth of God's Word (Isaiah 40:8).
