JACOB ROBERTS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Jacob Roberts Memorial Scholarship supports students who have chosen to pursue an Associate's Degree in Computer Information Systems and who maintain high academic standards. Each recipient is awarded a maximum of \$250.00 per semester.

To apply, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Application through your myNSCC. You must complete this application each year. We recommend that you submit your application early. **Scholarships are awarded to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-awarded basis until funds are expended.** Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Applicants must be pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Computer Information Systems. Recipients must not have earned a prior Bachelor's Degree.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.
- Applicants must have completed at least 12 credit hours of Computer Information System coursework with a minimum 2.75 grade point average.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing and meet satisfactory academic progress standards, as measured for federal Title IV Programs.

Students who receive the Jacob Roberts Memorial Scholarship in the Fall semester must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75, complete six credit hours and continue to meet the criteria listed above to remain eligible for the Spring disbursement of the scholarship.

Applicable maintenance fee / tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
