RANDY RAYBURN CULINARY ARTS SCHOLARSHIP**

The NSCC Foundation Randy Rayburn Culinary Arts Scholarship is made possible by contributions from local businessman, Randy Rayburn. Recipients are awarded the equivalent of full-time, in-state registration fee assessment based on 12 credit hours plus textbooks not to exceed \$2,575 per semester.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Applicants must be pursuing an Associate Degree in Culinary Arts at NSCC.
- Applicants must have achieved sophomore status.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.50 cumulative grade point average.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of twelve credit hours.

Recipients will be selected based on recommendations from the Culinary Arts Scholarship Committee.

Applicable maintenance fee / tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
