The NSCC Foundation Culinary Arts Scholarship is made possible by contributions from local businesses with an interest in promoting culinary education. Recipients are awarded a maximum of \$2000 each year.

To apply, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Application through your myNSCC. You must complete this application each year. We recommend that you submit your application early. **Scholarships are awarded to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-awarded basis until funds are expended.** Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Applicants must be pursuing an Associate Degree in Culinary Arts at NSCC.
- Applicants must have completed at least 30 hours toward the Culinary Arts Associate's Degree, exclusive of transfer coursework.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative grade point average.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.
- Applicants must agree to volunteer at the Tennessee Flavors event that occurs on the first or second Tuesday of March each year on the main campus.

Applicable maintenance fee / tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
