

Financial Aid Cost of Attendance:

The NSCC Financial Aid Office will calculate your cost of attendance (COA) which is used to calculate your eligibility for aid. These figures do not reflect the amount of money you are expected to come up with to attend NSCC includes indirect costs which you are probably already paying for such as housing and room and board. Your COA reflects the total amount of aid that you can from most Federal and State sources.

The following is a sample of how a student’s COA is calculated. Your actual COA will vary depending on the year you are attending.
