

- **What is a Credential?**
A credential is a three-day lift ticket (2/22-2/24) with access to event functions and hospitality.
- **What does my credential get me?**
Racer/Sponsor - For Corporate Challenge captains, racers, sponsors and NSCD guests. This three-day lift ticket also provides access to the Racers Tent, with open bar and lunch on Saturday and Sunday and the Guest Hospitality Tent snacks, soda, hot chocolate and beer.
Guest - A three-day lift ticket and snacks, soda, hot chocolate and beer at the Guest Hospitality Tent.
- **What is the Racers Tent?**
Access for guests with "Racer" on credential, including race team captains, racers, event sponsors and guests of the NSCD.
- **What is the Guest Hospitality Tent?**
Access to complimentary soda, hot chocolate, beer and snacks. An outdoor Ice Bar is open to all with signature drinks.
- **Why can't we call it "Bank Cup" anymore?**
The Bank Cup is another race not sponsored by Wells Fargo. Wells Fargo is very sensitive that we refer to the event as Ski Cup and not Bank Cup.
- **What is the Corral?**
The corral is the fenced-in area at the base of Lower Hughes. Area is for all guests of the event, regardless of credential type, to gather and watch the races. Home to Guest Hospitality Tent, Racers Tent, NSCD info and race bib pick-up.
- **What is an Athlete Experience?**
Guests can sign up at the NSCD registration table to ski in adaptive equipment, including ski bikes and sit skis. These two clinics are Friday only. Must pre-register.
- **What is a Race Clinic?**
Guests can sign up at the NSCD registration table for helpful tips and tricks to improve their race skills. These two clinics are Friday only and are taught by the NSCD's very own Competition Center coaches. Must pre-register.
- **What is the World Disabled Invitational (WDI)?**
Race on Sunday for professional athletes with disabilities. Athletes can earn prize money to help them on the competitive circuit. It is the only race where all disciplines race directly against each other.
- **What is the Corporate Challenge?**
Teams are composed of 5 corporate racers plus an elite racer with a disability.
- **What is the AEC Challenge?**
Architects, engineers and contractors compete in an industry specific race on Friday afternoon to win the Outrigger Cup and industry bragging rights.
- **When does the race start?**
The AEC Challenge is Friday at 2pm. Corporate Challenge begins at 10:30am on Saturday. The Kids Snowplow Sprint is Sunday at 10am with the WDI following at 11am.
- **Where is race registration?**
Racer registration is in West Portal Station in the sack lunch zone, outside NSCD lesson/equipment room.
- **Where do I get my race bib?**
Racer bibs can be picked up Saturday morning between 7:30am - 9:30am at the NSCD/Race info table inside the corral.
- **Where is the race held?**
All 3 races are held on Lower Hughes at the base of Gondola.
- **How does the race run?**
Teams compete in heats of 3 racers, from three teams at a time. The winning team of each heat advances. Prizes are given to the top three teams with cash prizes for the elite athletes.
- **What is the fastest way to get to race course?**
You can ride either the Gondola or Arrow Chair lift to access the race course. Arrow brings you in at a lower point closer to the race course start.
- **What other activities are going on this weekend?**
Friday: Racer Dinner 6:30pm - 10:00pm.
Invitation only.
Saturday: Après Ski Bash at the auction tent - open to the public 3pm - 5pm.
Sunday: Kids Snowplow Sprint - open to youth ages 5 - 12 of WFSC guests. *Limited availability.
Sunday: Ski for NSCD Celebration & Sarah Holm Memorial WDI Awards.
- **What is Ski for NSCD?**
This is an individual or team fundraising program. Raise money for NSCD and receive more incentives the more money you raise!
- **Is there an auction?**
