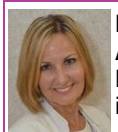
Megan Brunson, MSN, RN, CNL, CCRN-CSC AACN President, 2019-2020

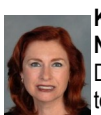
Heather Hand, RN, CCRN, CNRN, LNC Clinical Specialist for Zoll/ Neuro ICU RN
