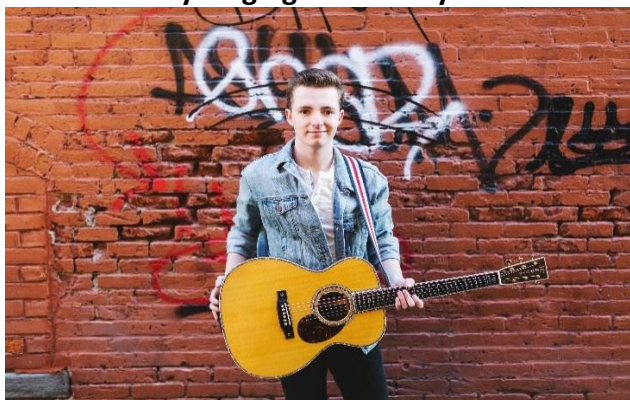

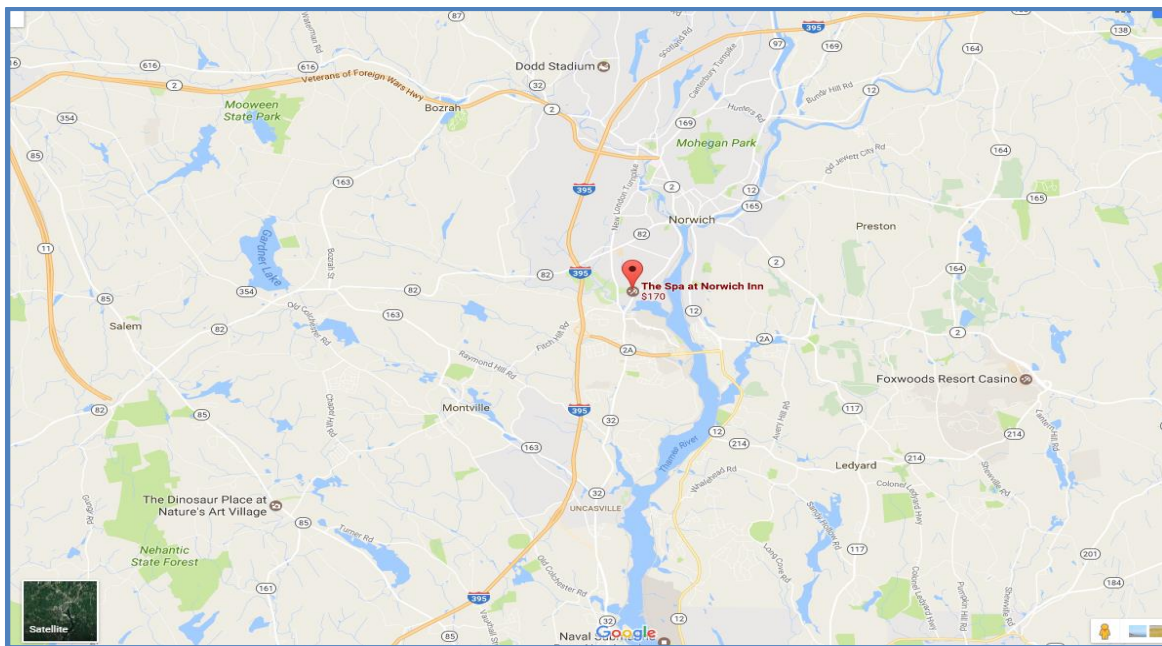


Hotel Reservations
