NOVEMBER 7, 2017 Meeting Minutes

Attendees: Louann Huffman, President; Barb Adkins, President Elect; Marie Barrentine, Vice President; Julia Jackson, Secretary designee; Valerie Heckmaster, Treasurer; Denett Costin, Board Member; Tracy Porter, Board Member. Teresa Kuehn has resigned as Secretary due to health reasons. Thank you to Julia Jackson who has stepped up as a volunteer as Secretary. **October meeting:** Held at North Kansas City Hospital. Attendance was 68 people, including three new members. Chapter delegates were announced, based on activity points. A donation of \$128 was made by the chapter to the Colon Cancer Coalition (thank you note received by Louann). Education program focused on surgical smoke evacuation. **Financials:** Ending balance for October is \$25,462.22 in checking, \$19,168.20 in savings and \$6826.00 in CD (see financial sheet for details). Valerie initiated discussion about methods of registering for chapter events: Stripe charges Chapter \$3.50 each time someone goes through Nursing Network to register for an event, and we already charge \$5 more for people who register online. Tracy suggested others that don't charge as much: PayPal, Venmo. Plan to research options that are less expensive, and suggestions welcome! **AORN Chapter Challenge:** Greater Kansas City chapter tied for 1st place with 20 new members recruited. \$1000 already deposited. Thank you to Tracy for getting a wine tasting meet and greet with new members, board members, and committee chairs for Saturday, November 18, 2-4 at Cooper's Hawk on the Plaza. **Perioperative Nurses Week, November 12-18:** Louann will bring a cake for meeting. Denice and Louann sent notifications to local newspapers; please bring copies if you see them in a paper. Received proclamations from states of Kansas & Missouri. We'd like to know what our hospitals are doing for Perioperative Nurses week. **AORN Town Hall:** Thursday November 16; Louann can send an invitation and link for anyone who wants to attend. Additionally, she's invited, and will attend, a **Missouri Nursing and Policy update in Jefferson City** on Nov. 13. **Nominating Committee update:** Available positions: President Elect; Vice President; Secretary; Board Members (2); Nominating Committee (3). We have 3 who've agreed to run for various positions, but would like additional candidates. Members are encouraged to ask questions about the roles and duties of positions they may be interested in! **AORN Conference & Expo:** Chosen through chapter activity points, 10 delegates have committed. 
