1615—1620 Program Evaluation and Summary

**Outcome:** To enable the perianesthesia nurse to increase knowledge on post anesthesia delirium, pediatric perianesthesia respiratory risk assessment and management of respiratory complications, perianesthesia concerns for geriatric patients and managing toxic work environments demonstrated by 80% or more of the participants scoring 80% or higher on the post test.
