In Memory of Donna DeMotts-Fitzpatrick, RN Emergency and Flight Nurse

On December 6, 2009, Nevada lost a pioneer in emergency and flight nursing. Donna DeMotts-Fitzpatrick started her flight nursing career at Valley Hospital Medical Center in Las Vegas, Nevada. Both Reno and Las Vegas had developed and implemented flight programs and were recruiting and training nurses to perform advanced practice and life-saving procedures while responding to medical and trauma calls throughout the state. This all started in the early 1980's. This was still a very new frontier of nursing in the state of Nevada although there were many other well established programs in the USA.

Donna immediately took to her new job and soon became an outstanding member of the flight team. She got her EMS Instructor rating and also went on to be one of the first nursing members of the Metro Search and Rescue Team. Her delight with flying sent her to ground school and on to her private fixed wing pilot license. After several years of flying with the Valley Hospital Flight for Life team as a charge nurse and then Chief Flight Nurse, Donna decided she needed yet another challenge. At age 40, she became the oldest female recruit to attend the Metropolitan Police Academy. She successfully completed the academy and transitioned into her role as a police officer. However, it became clear to Donna that police work was very different from nursing, and she made the decision to return to healthcare. Donna then worked with the Critical Care Transport Team at University Medical Center as well as working in the Trauma Resus area.

Her final contributions were made at the Las Vegas City Fire Department where she provided continuing education and certification classes and worked with the paramedic program. Donna was a well respected member of the EMS and nursing community in Las Vegas. Her love of learning and dedication to teaching and promoting excellence in patient care is well remembered by all the personnel and staff that she worked with in her

25 year career in Las Vegas. Donna always passed out tootsie pops during her lectures and carried them faithfully in her pockets on mountain rescues and desert searches. She is fondly remembered for always attending to the needs of everyone, especially in the nourishment department!! Her wonderful spirit as a co-worker, friend, mentor and nurse with many talents and abilities will be sorely missed by everyone who knew her. She leaves a loving family, many friends and two great dogs who miss her immensely. Thank you, Donna, for all of your dedication and service to our community and for the many lives that you saved.
