Therapy Assessment (Physical/Occupational/Speech)

Maintaining or regaining strength is critical to life independence. Licensed therapists will discuss mobility, strength, and movement issues, which contribute to fall risk—the leading cause for elder hospitalization.

Nutritional Counseling Assessment

Food is often overlooked in a home care program. Our "Food Doctor" is a Registered Dietitian who will review your plan of care and medical records, to help determine the best food options to thrive at home.

Coaching & Cooking Session

After the Registered Dietitian creates the menu, our organic chef will bring it to life with cooking sessions in your home, to prepare healthy meals for several days.

Psychology Evaluation

Our clients and families are going through major life changes and may benefit from speaking with a therapist. Our partners specialize in aging issues such as sadness, loss of memory, independence, and significant others.


