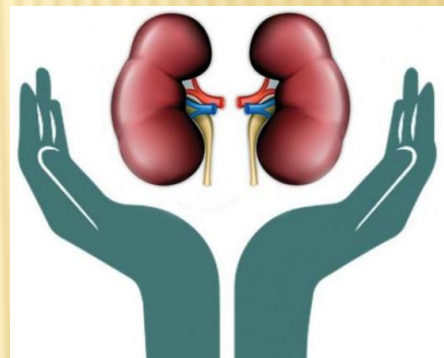

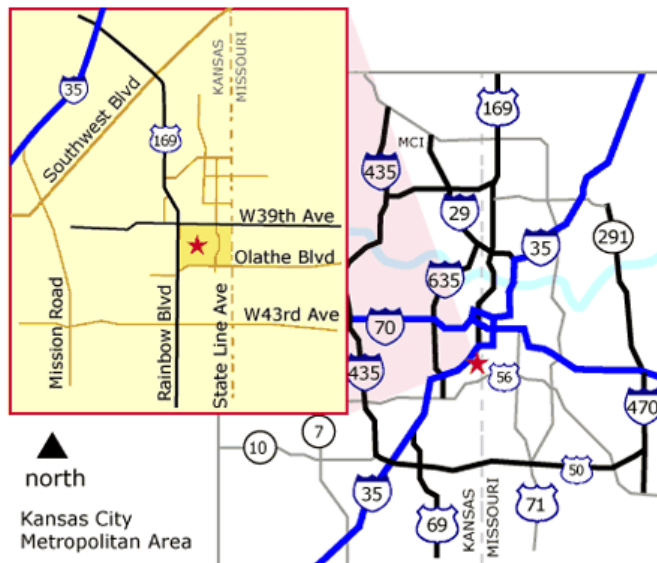

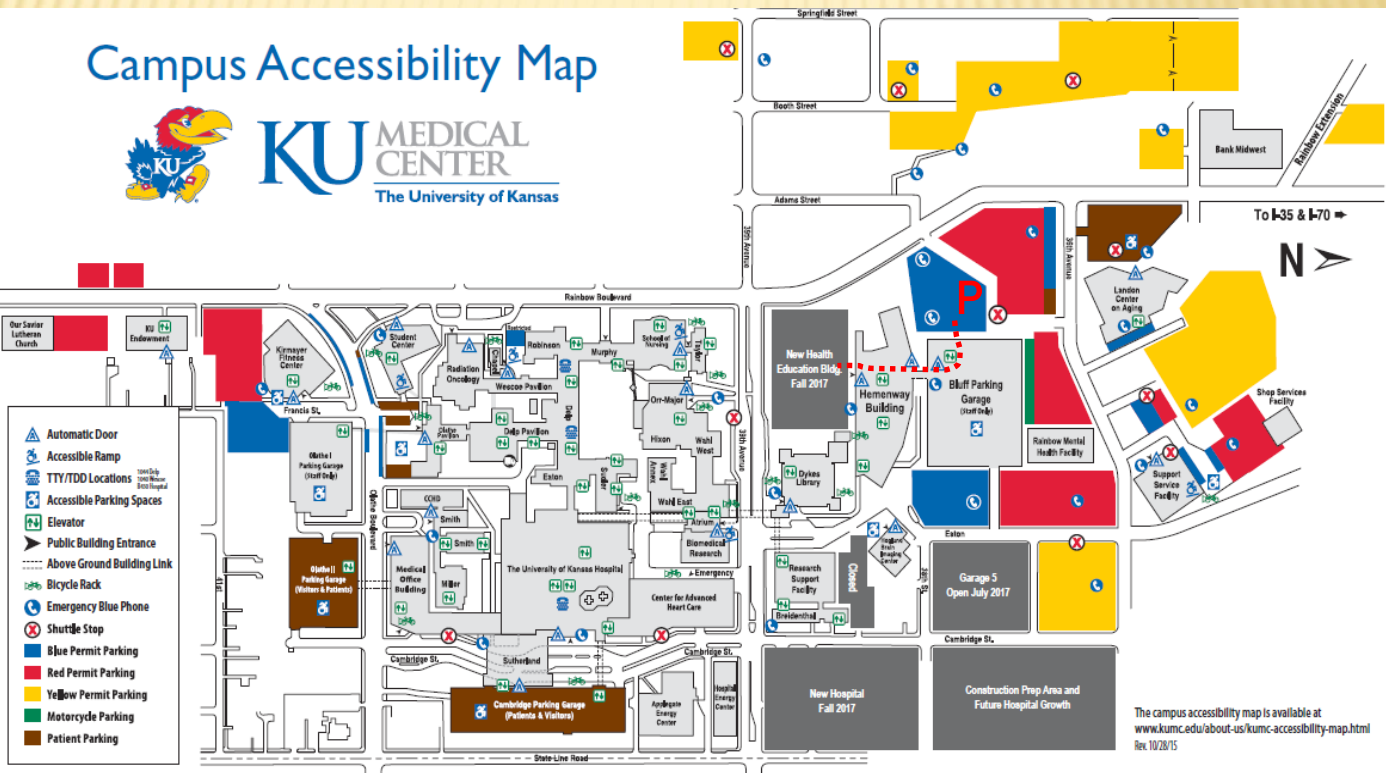
Directions to the University of Kansas Medical Center
