The University of Iowa Emergency Department is located in Iowa City, Iowa, just off of busy Interstate 80. At University of Iowa Healthcare (UIHC) we have a 44 bed emergency department



that serves more than 60,000 patients annually. Our facility includes rooms specialized for all possible emergencies including: trauma / resuscitations, HEENT, behavioral health, pediatric, and HAZMAT. Along with our specialized and general exam rooms, we have five triage spaces that focus on timely assessment and movement of patients from the waiting room to the main ED. We have a 24 / 7 in house trauma response team to the Emergency Department that is led by the Department of Surgery and has in house specialty consults, including orthopedic surgery, neurosurgery, otolaryngology, ophthalmology, and anesthesia to name a few.

Our ED team is comprised of a large talented group of registered nurses, nursing assistants, paramedics, residents, staff physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants.
