Thanks go to Mike Nelson of 3M for providing dinner. Meeting minutes: March business minutes appeared in newsletter and were approved as written. AORN Expo recap: We won "Top Star Award" for Chapter Accountability Standards (includes education and Contact Hours, business meetings, member growth, treasurer's report, # delegates at Expo). Trophy on display at April meeting. Our chapter sent 13 funded delegates (10 based on point sheet totals, plus the President, President-Elect, and winner of the First-time Attendee Essay). There were 4 poster presentations from KC area hospitals—North Kansas City Hospital's PeriOp 101 group (Tia Kennedy, Sara Coslet, Sarah Jacobs & mentor Denice Morrison), and 3 from Children's Mercy perioperative nurses (Caleigh Brown, Meredith Kopp, Sabrina Yasso, Gentry Ehlert, Mark Besinger). Congratulations to Jessica Garden from CMH, who won an award for her poster on prewarming orthopedic spine patients! (If you attended the chapter workshop and vendor fair on February 24, you had a chance to see the posters before Expo.) Community Service: Melissa Harber reports we collected \$190 in March for Battle Buddy Service Dogs (provided to Veterans), and received a "thank you" note from BBSD. April donations will go to Restoration House of Greater KC, helping to heal and empower victims of sex trafficking. This year our chapter has collected for various organizations: old cell phones (SAFEHOME); pop tabs (Ronald McDonald House); diapers (Happy Bottoms Diaper Bank); empty pill bottles (Medical Missions Warehouse @ Franciscan Sisters). Service Projects have included sorting surgical supplies and instruments at the Missions Warehouse, with 6 members helping April 7. Membership: Barb Adkins reports 341 members for our chapter as of April; all are encouraged to get involved through participation in committees, service projects and other activities offered for the 2018-19 year, starting with our September 18<sup>th</sup> meeting and educational offering. Attendance at meetings and committee involvement increase your opportunity to attend Expo as a funded delegate from our chapter (through the activity record/ point sheet), as well as networking with other members! Fundraising: Deanna Cross delivered gift cards at the meeting that had been ordered earlier, earning our chapter \$91.
