Section 1

- A. These bylaws may be amended by voting members. Bylaws amendments that receive a two-thirds affirmative vote of the votes cast will become effective immediately upon certification of the voting results.
- B. Proposed amendments shall have been approved by the Board of Directors.
- C. A copy of the proposed amendments shall be sent to voting members at least thirty (30) days in advance of the vote.

Section 2

Any amendment to these bylaws that directly relates to the business of the chapters shall automatically and immediately effect the necessary amendments to the bylaws of the chapters.

Article XIV Amendments

- A. These bylaws may be amended by voting members. Bylaws amendments that receive a two-thirds affirmative vote of the votes cast will become effective immediately upon certification of the voting results.
- B. Proposed amendments shall have been approved by the Board of Directors.
- C. A copy of the proposed amendments shall be sent to voting members at least thirty (30) days in advance of the vote.

Chapter bylaws do not need to align with AAOHN National Bylaws.
