10:00 AM - 1:00 PM: Developing Empathy for the Lived Experience of Psychiatric Disability: A Simulation of Hearing Distressing Voices

This three hour training includes a presentation on the phenomenon of hearing distressing voices; the simulation experience; and a discussion period. Participants will learn about the subjective experience of hearing distressing voices and increase their appreciation of the day-to-day challenges facing people with psychiatric disabilities.
