- ›Presenter name/s
- ›Objective
- ›Background
- ›Significance to the Field of Nursing
- ›Research Method/s
- ›Findings and Implications

The KNA Poster Selection Committee will use this information to select submissions:

Focus	Criteria
Title/Presenter Name	Is the title clearly stated/easily read? Is the title appropriate for the study?
Research Objective	Does the abstract clearly and precisely state the objective(s) and/or research question (hypothesis)?
Background	Is there evidence of an adequate review of literature to support the research question (hypothesis)?
Significance to the Field of Nursing	Does the abstract: a. Clearly indicate how the research is significant to nursing? b. Demonstrate how the research project promotes best practice? c. Contribute to the body of nursing knowledge?
Method(s)	Is the method used for the research appropriate?
Findings	Are the findings clearly stated?
Implications	Are the implications for nursing practice clearly articulated?
