She received a Master of Arts in Human Sexuality and a Master of Clinical Social Work from New York University. Dr. Ashby received her Doctorate in Counseling Psychology from Columbia University. Dr. Ashby is dually appointed as Assistant Clinical Professor in the Departments of Obstetrics & Gynecology and Psychiatry at Morehouse School of Medicine and is currently in practice in Atlanta, GA.

Dr. Ashby has also been a consultant to many agencies and companies. She is currently a consultant to Johnson Publishing, specifically Ebony Magazine. In this capacity Dr. Ashby has written various articles around Black female sexuality, and developed an international survey for the magazine on the sexual attitudes and behaviors of Black women. Dr. Ashby has presented at various professional national and international conferences around the sexuality needs of women.
