Message from GMAC President Jennifer Prom

Then a life event occurred that shifted my trajectory and this meaning changed for me. My mother-in-law had become very ill and spent 7 weeks in the hospital. Her stay started in the ICU and ended with Inpatient Rehab before discharging home. I remember my father-in-law advocating for her and the nursing staff pushing her to get better. During her hospitalization, a couple of nurses stood out because they were relentless in their tactics to get her better. They spoke up to the doctors when their gut told them "something wasn't right" and pushed her when she needed to get out of bed and move. I saw how nurses would not stop to do what was right for their patient. They were *unstoppable*. This compassion for people and persistence to do what was right motivated me to quit my job and go back to school full time for my BSN.

I have learned as a nurse that there are so many ways to explain how we are unstoppable. Megan Brunson, our AACN president, summed it up beautifully, "Unstoppable is knowing if we get knocked down, we get up again. It's using our unique talents to expose inefficiencies and celebrate positive, innovative solutions, no matter how small". I hope this year in reflecting on this theme we can be encouraged by this sense of empowerment and remember just how much of an impact we make every day. From starting out as the family member of a patient to becoming one of you, please know that you are making a difference and an impact even if you don't always feel it. You are all unstoppable!
