HALLOWEEN CAN BE SCARY... BUT COLORECTAL CANCER CAN BE TOO!

5 Frightful Facts about Colorectal Cancer (CRC):

- 6 Colorectal cancer is the #3 cancer in the US and the world. It doesn't discriminate against age, gender, race, ethnicity, or socio-economic status.
- 6 Colorectal cancer is on the rise in young adults. People born in 1990 are 2x more likely to get colon cancer and 4x more likely to get rectal cancer than people born in 1950.
- Young adults are more likely to get misdiagnosed with hemorrhoids or IBS before getting diagnosed with colorectal cancer which is then in advanced stages and more difficult to treat.
- It is projected that by **2030** colon cancer rates for people between 20 and 34 will increase by **90%** and rectal cancer rates will increase by **124%** in that same age group. There is also a prediction of a **28%** increase in colorectal cancer in people age 35-49.
- While there are many risk factors for colorectal cancer, many young adults don't have any risk factors and are **below** the screening age.

So What Can You Do to Decrease Your Risk?

- Learn your risk factors for colorectal cancer at <u>www.cancer.org</u>.
- Change your lifestyle to reduce your risk: stop using tobacco products; maintain a healthy weight; be physically active which means exercising as well as not sitting for long periods; eat a healthy diet by eating more fruits and vegetables and less processed foods and red meat; and limit intake of alcohol.
- 6 Know your family's cancer history particularly in **first** and **second** degree relatives. There can be a genetic connection between CRC and other types of cancer.
- Go for routine and recommended follow up exams.
- Pay attention to your body and report changes to your doctor.
- Be your own advocate. Speak up when something is wrong even if you're not sure if it's significant. Seek a 2nd opinion if you don't think you're being taken seriously.
