What:

The Emory University Department of Emergency Medicine's Section of Prehospital and Disaster Medicine is providing medical support for America's Marathon Weekend. This is a unique opportunity to provide medical coverage for the U.S. Olympic Team Marathon Trials, as well as for the runners participating in the Publix Atlanta Marathon, Half Marathon & 5K. It's a fun day spent in Centennial Olympic Park. We typically see approximately 200 patients in the tents with a multitude of complaints. This is a great opportunity to learn about event medicine, EMS, and to practice your skills out in the field. We would love to have you participate and hang out with us in the medical tents. You don't have to volunteer for both days, but we would love to have you for both events.

We can't pay you, but lunch and volunteer t-shirts will be provided. We will also provide you with a letter for The Professional Lattice for Advancement in Nursing (The Plan). If you have special dietary needs, please plan accordingly.

Who We Need: EMTs, ED Technicians, Medical Registration, Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants, and Registered Nurses.

- 2. Enter the password "medical" into the password slot and submit.
- 3. The medical positions are organized by the event date and time.

- 4. Select the medical position for which you wish to volunteer.
 - a. **Please note:** If you wish to volunteers for both events (2 days), you must select one Olympic Trials position and one Publix Atlanta Marathon position.
 - b. If you **DO NOT** wish to volunteer for both events (both days), you must select the "Medical Volunteer Second Shift" checkbox at the top of the list along with selecting the one position you wish to fill. Please read the description for more information.
- 5. Enter your information and provide your Emory email address.
- 6. "Training Session Requirement":
 - a. As a medical volunteer, you are *not* required to attending a training session through the Atlanta Track Club. Just-in-Time training will be provided the morning of the event by Emory Emergency Medicine.
 - b. Medical protocols and other documents will be sent over email for review in advance of the events.
- 7. Select the checkboxes to agree to the policies and disclaimers, sign, and submit.
