currently being offered and save the sessions you are most interested in attending. Check it out, and don't forget to register soon!

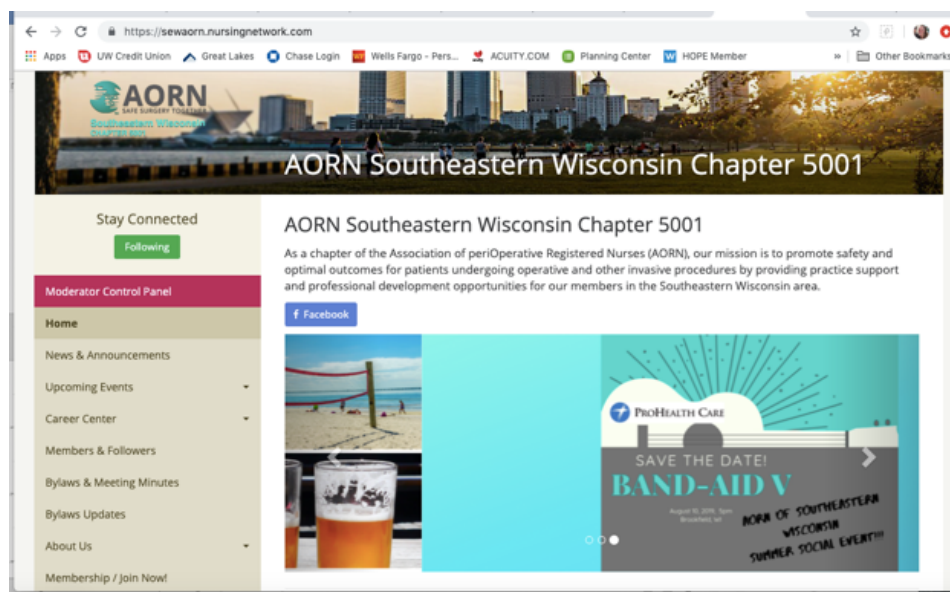

# Secretary Nominees

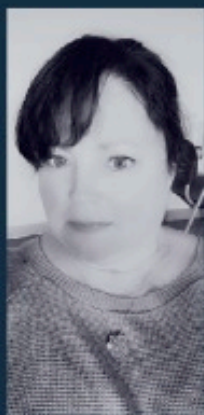
## Danielle Ament, BSN, RN, CNOR

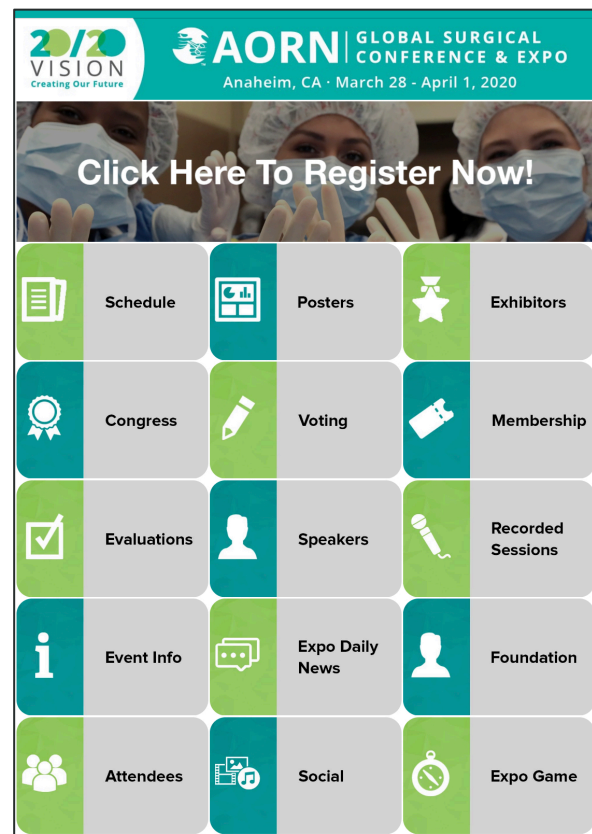
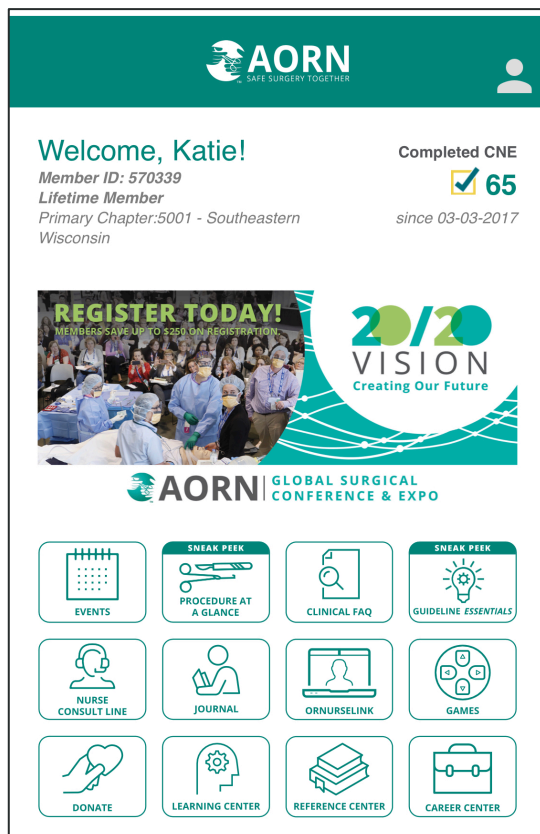
