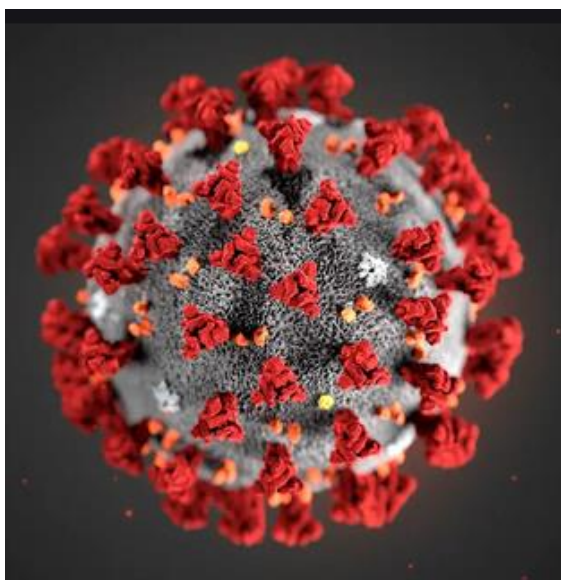


COVID-19 CONVERSATIONS INNOVATING THE LEARNING EXPERIENCE
