The Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner (AG ACNP) is prepared to provide services ranging from disease prevention to critical care. Preventing complications, restoring health and providing palliative care are important aspects of the role.

UWM's 18-credit postgraduate AG ACNP certificate prepares students for certification and licensure as Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioners. Upon completing the certificate requirements, students will be eligible to sit for the national certification exam offered by the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) or by the American Association of Critical Care Nurses (AACN).
