Committee Reports

Education: Committee members change every year based on location of annual conference, Des Moines area or eastern Iowa. Pam will send emails to each region and ask for volunteers to join the planning committee.

- The 2020 conference was canceled due to COVID-19; the planning committee included Denise, Dawn and Becky. Denise is now retired and hesitant to commit to 2021 conference planning.
- Date of annual conference: July 21,

2021. Group agreed with plan to keep same theme and speakers from 2020, Dr. Regan Geisinger and Dr. Patrick McNamara from UISFCH. - Susan has attended ARNP Day on the Hill and found legislators to be very responsive to concerns of ARNP group.
