The death of a woman that occurs due to complications of pregnancy or childbirth or up to one year after giving birth


What we know?

- Annually, severe complications
 affect > 65,000 women in the U.S
 - On average, 700 women die annually in the United States from complications
 - Social determinants of health a factor
 - Tragic trend in the U.S


Death can happen up to a year after delivery



$Social \\ Contributing \\ Factors$




