National speakers Terry Johnson and Jamie Strott will be speaking about the "Microbiome & Optimum Nutrition for the Cardiac Baby" and then again about moral distress and how it affects us as nurses. Patrick McNamara will speak about PDA management, Regan Giesinger will speak about neonatal hypotension, and Bassel Mohammed Nijres will speak about transcatheter PDA closure in small babies.

Here are some fun facts about congenital heart disease from an article by Gleb (2015).

- * Thomas Bevill Peacock was a London physician in the 1800's and is credited as the first to present CHD in an organized fashion and looked at fetal circulation and possible environmental effects of heart defects
- * Maude Abbott was a renowned pathologist at McGill University in the early 1900's. She studied causes of CHD, family recurrence, and genetics of CHD.

- * Robert Gross performed the first patent ductus arteriosus ligation in 1939
- * Helen Brooke Taussig is the most famous pediatric cardiologist of all time and practiced in the 1930's and 1940's. She studied the correlation of environmental toxicants to the fetus and the origins of CHD. The first Blalock-Taussig-Thomas shunt surgery was performed in 1944.

Look how far care for these patients has come. Plan to attend on July 21 to learn recent information about a variety of cardiac topics and management.


