

October 20, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 6:33 pm by Emily Spellman.

Welcome & Introductions: Emily asked members and guests to introduce themselves.

Meeting Sponsors from Abbott Nutrition: Mindy Crawford, MBA, RD-Clinical Specialist; Brooke Krog, RD, LD

Abbott Presentation: Update on Similac Probiotic Tri-Blend: Suitable for hospital use, mixes easily with small volumes of breast milk, use one sachet per day mixed with 3ml breastmilk, donor breastmilk, formula, or sterile water. Update on Similac HMF HP CL. Update on Similac premature nutrition discharge program: Families can receive one free case of specialty products, including HMF; also includes NeoSure product. Mindy shared the discharge program enrollment form. New from Abbott: 24/7 Online Nutrition Hub, Pediatric ProConnect. Brooke Krog offered to provide support for future initiatives and educational programs sponsored by IANN. Emily will follow-up with Brooke regarding future collaboration with Abbott.

Good News & Recognitions: 1) Emily recognized LouAnn Montgomery from UIHC who was recently inducted as a Fellow in the American Academy of Nursing. 2) Several IANN members from Cedar Rapids, St. Luke's recently graduated from the Trauma Informed Care Program: Jenny Haverly, Jenni Montgomery, Megan Laetare. Emily announced that UIHC received a grant to fund cost of attendance for 50 staff members. Barb Smith is currently enrolled in the program. She reported that Blank Children's Hospital received a discount on cost to attend, 10-20%. Barb stated that the modules are interesting and worth the time commitment. 3) Becky Chuffo-Davila (Listening Visits) and Jessica Wallace (Cooling Program Update) will be presenters at Iowa Neonatology Day on October 22, 2021.

Officer Reports-

President: Emily Spellman reported that NANN has created a link to the video presented at the 37th Annual Conference, "The American Nurses Project and Defining Hope" by author and filmmaker Carolyn Jones. The video is available for chapters to view, Emily suggested that we might show the video during the January 2022 business meeting. Several attendees reported that the video was excellent. Emily provided a recap of the 8th Annual Neonatal Care Virtual Conference-Matters of the Heart, held on July 21, 2021: 43 attendees, granted 5.0 contact hours of CE credit to nurses, 8 vendors participated, several door prizes were awarded including one conference registration for 2022. Emily offered thanks to members of the conference planning committee.

Vice President: Kayti Steffen had no report.

Secretary: Penny Smith had no report.

Treasurer: Becky Chuffo-Davila submitted a financial report.

Chair Reports-

Communications: Erin Weber had no report.

Membership: Pam Kalkhoff reported current IANN membership at 83 members. She reported that there are 15 nurses in Iowa who are members of NANN, but not members of IANN.

Committee Reports-

Advocacy & Outreach: Becky informed the group that the March of Dimes annual chef auction will take place in November.

NICU Sharing: UnityPoint Health-Blank Children's Hospital – Barb Smith, MSN, RNC-NIC reported on several initiatives: 1) NLRN Residency Program: For newly licensed and registered NICU nurses, 1-year program that includes 8 hours of class time every other Tuesday for 6 months, then additional 6 months spent on a defined QI project. Projects are presented at nurse residency graduation. 2) Blank Children's Hospital recently applied for certification as a Gold-Certified Safe Sleep Hospital through Cribs for Kids, led by Deanna Robey, unit-based educator. 3) Baby Buzz: Quarterly newsletter with distribution list of 500, Barb Smith is the editor, covers various topics related to newborn care. 4) Multiple ongoing QI Projects: Maquet masks and nasal prong CPAP, NAS QI with Iowa Neonatal Quality Collaborative (INQC), updating IVH bundle, implemented probiotics, lines and surfactant for ELBW infants, bedside education cart, NICU skills day that included a chest tube "escape room." Barb stated that she has been asked by the National Certification Corporation to write test questions for the RNC-NIC certification exam. She has also been selected to be a transcript reviewer for the NANN journal, Advances in Neonatal Care. Barb will be presenting on HIE and total body cooling at the upcoming Cooperative Care Conference at Blank Children's Hospital. Barb is a facilitator for NLRN projects at Blank and she is a member of the Board of Directors for INQC.

NICU Sharing: ChildServe – Dawn Schwartz, ARNP is the Vice President of Care Quality at ChildServe in Johnston, IA. She reported that 15% of Iowa's children have special healthcare needs, 106,000 kids. ChildServe is the only organization of its kind, providing over 30 programs and services under one roof. It is the largest provider of pediatric rehabilitation services in the Midwest and the largest non-profit organization in Iowa. ChildServe employs 1500 people statewide, providing acute services, post-acute services and community services. Dawn encouraged the group to follow ChildServe on social media.
