DESCRIPTION

The percentage of survivors who have metastases at diagnosis is variable, depending upon the cancer type. For many of our patients, treatment goals become complex. As patients face late-stage disease, the role for navigation is even more critical. Patient-centered care coordination within multidisciplinary care requires a true collaboration. A variety of skills are required, including our ability to achieve trust and connection with our patients during their vulnerable and long journey.

Nurse practitioners, nurses, oncology nurse navigators, administrators, care coordinators, fellows, medical students, nursing students, patient navigators, community health workers, case managers, social workers, psychologists, patient advocates, community ambassadors, lay health advisors, community educators, peer support specialists, and lay volunteer patient navigators.

- Discuss findings and implication of psychedelic research and emotional distress in advanced and metastatic patients

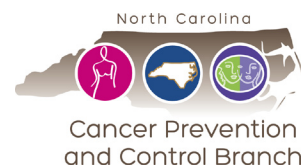
