#### KNOW WHAT YOU'RE DEALING WITH

- Understand your diagnosis. Read about it at Cancer.gov/Types.
- Avoid infertility. Preserve your chances of having children after treatment; learn how at MyOncoFertility.org.
- Get proactive. Find questions to ask your doctor about AYA-specific cancer care on our website, FWAYA.org.

#### **BUILD YOUR SUPPORT SYSTEM**

- Online communities and support groups are great for venting or comparing notes with fellow AYAs.

- Camps and retreats offer opportunities to go hiking, rafting and more with fellow AYAs - usually for free. Find a list on our website.
