Donating Ostomy and Medical Supplies

General tips:

Supplies must be clean, and unused. Accessory products like powder and paste must not be open.

- 1. Clean, unused but expired supplies could be used for teaching so check with your local nursing school. Some charities may take expired products but you should check first.
- 2. Check with your hospital or doctor **before** dropping off supplies. Many facilities do not have storage space or they have rules against accepting these supplies.
- 3. If you're in a support group, check with members and/or have it listed in their newsletter.
- 4. Donate to medical missions like MedShare.
- 5. Supplies like syringes and dressings can be donated to your veterinarian or a free medical clinic.
