## Letter from the IANN President

Greetings IANN members. I hope you had a great summer and are ready to move into fall. It was recently Neonatal Nurses Day. I hope all of you had a chance to celebrate all that we do for the patients and families in the NICU and to remember your "why". I had the opportunity to attend the NANN conference virtually this year. I have not watched all the presentations or reviewed all the posters yet, but what I have watched is inspiring and informative. The speaker topics range from clinical to family support to nurse support. I love the virtual format of the posters because I can read them carefully, have access to them for a while, and can listen to the presenter's recording explaining their work. I learn so much and get great ideas about EBP and QI projects in NICUs across the country. One poster by Weisbart et al. from UCLA Health is called Fight the Burnout: A Wellness Bundle for NICU Nurses. It is no surprise that decreased burnout in nurses is linked with increased patient satisfaction, less missed workdays, better health of the nurses, increased job performance, and less turnover which saves money. The literature review showed that three key elements in the work environment have been associated with predicting burnout: staffing, meaningful recognition, and effective decision making. The interventions used in their NICU were meaningful recognition, nurturing of interpersonal connections, and mindfulness-based interventions to

decrease burnout. This group had specific activities in their wellness bundle to address each of these areas that included posting staff shoutouts, recognition events and dinners, staff games with prizes, social events, wellness tip sheets, and mindfulness activities at staff meetings and huddles. I would love to hear from all of you about what your NICU does to recognize staff, create interpersonal connections, and foster mindfulness.

Plan to join us in Cedar Rapids on October 19<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 for our next IANN meeting and lunch provided by Mead Johnson Nutrition. Everyone is welcome to join! We are also planning to have a Zoom option.

**Conference Sharing:** Denise Easley attended the NANN annual conference and submitted a summary statement from the talk by Carol M. Wallman, DNP, APRN, NNP-BC entitled, "Marijuana, Breast Feeding, and the Use of Human Milk."

**Approval of meeting minutes from April 20, 2022:** April meeting minutes were sent out with June 2022 newsletter. Becky Davila motioned to approve minutes; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Denise Easley. Minutes were approved.

Officer Reports-

**President: Emily Spellman** reminded group that according to IANN bylaws officers elections should be held every 2 years. Emily does not plan to continue as president after this term. She encouraged members to nominate yourself or others for an IANN board position if you are interested in running for office. Pam Kalkhoff will send out the ballot for electronic voting in August, and we will present the slate at the October 2022 meeting.

Vice President: Kayti Steffen had no report.

Secretary: Penny Smith had no report.

**Treasurer: Becky Chuffo-Davila** submitted a financial report. Education funds are available for IANN members. We had a brief discussion regarding anticipated expenses this year. Becky will add up the credits received from annual conference.

## **Chair Reports-**

Communications: Erin Weber had no report. Membership: Pam Kalkhoff had no report.

Conference Planning Committee: Barb Smith reported that there were 37 registered participants and 14 vendors (7 paid vendor fee). Dr. Brown's sponsored the conference luncheon; 9 door prizes were given away. Group agreed that it is not too late to give away a free registration for next year's conference. Barb will follow up on this.

## **Committee Reports-**

Advocacy & Outreach: Jean Weber reported for Cyndie Homewood on recent meeting of statewide Perinatal Guidelines Advisory Committee. The Statewide Perinatal Care team in collaboration with the Iowa Department of Public Health is working to get birthing hospitals verified in their assigned level designations for maternal and neonatal care (Level II and III hospitals only). Level IV centers will not be verified by SWPC team, they will be required to hire an outside review team. A LOCATe survey developed by CDC was sent to all birthing facilities. The CEO and OB nurse manager will receive the survey results from IDPH prior to a verification site visit conducted by the SWPC team. At least two weeks before the site visit, hospitals will submit policies and other materials to prove that they are in compliance with Iowa code, https://www.legis.iowa.gov/docs/iac/chapter/641.150.pdf. During verification site visits, review team will have face to face discussions with unit mangers and hospital administrators to get a feel for what that facility is currently doing. This will help the team to make a more informed decision regarding level designation. The goal will be to have all initial Level II and III verification site visits completed by the end of the calendar year 2023. According to Iowa code , the process of reverification of a hospital participating in the regionalized system of perinatal health care will take place once every three years. However, the PGAC agreed that hospitals might find this challenging for

various reasons. More discussion is needed regarding whether or not this is an appropriate timeframe for reverification. Review team members will be reaching out to other states to gather more information about this. Dr. Dennis Rosenblum is current chairperson of PGAC. Discussions were begun to identify a potential vice chair who could take over as chair when Dr. Rosenblum leaves the position. A proper quorum was not available at this meeting for voting, so this will be discussed at next meeting. The Iowa Guidelines for Perinatal Services, 9<sup>th</sup> Edition will soon be published online at the IDPH website. Majority of PGAC members agreed with the plan for the SWPC team to establish a formal method for periodic review of the guidelines with the goal of making this a "living" document where authors will be responsible for keeping their appendix current. The process for this is not defined yet, but it will allow for current updates and changes in real time as they happen.

Penny Smith reported on recent activity of Iowa Neonatal Quality Collaborative. IDPH has applied for CDC grant that will be awarded to 22 states to support development of Perinatal Quality Collaboratives. Grant funding will total \$275,000/yr for 5 years. Steph Trusty at IDPH believes Iowa is positioned well to receive grant, states will be notified at end of September. If Iowa is awarded grant, INQC and the Iowa Maternal Quality Care Collaborative (IMQCC) will merge to form Iowa Perinatal Quality Collaborative.
