The Milwaukee VA is hiring RNs, LPNs and CNAs.

Enjoy the perks of a career with VA:

Tuition Reimbursement / Education Scholarships

After one year of service with VA, RNs, LPNs and CNAs can apply for tuition scholarships if they are working on bachelor degrees, masters degrees or healthcare-related advanced degrees.

Loan Forgiveness

VA is a qualifying employer for the Public Loan Forgiveness program which forgives the remaining balance of qualifying student loans after 10 years of payment.

Work-life balance

RNs earn 8 hours annual leave a pay period, equaling 26 days a year. 12 weeks paid-parental leave. LPNs and CNAs earn between 4-8 hours annual leave per pay period, depending on their years of service with the VA.

Federal Employee Health Benefits

More than 12 insurance plans to choose from for employees, their spouses, and children under age 26.

Variety of Nursing Career Options and Upward Mobility

RNs, LPNs and CNAs can work in a variety of settings in different units and departments. VA prides itself on its skilled mentors and ability to grow leaders.

Thrift Savings Plan (401K)

TSP is the federal government's version of a 401K with traditional (pre-tax) and Roth (after-tax) plans available.

Federal Pension

The Federal Employee Retirement System (FERS) serves as a pension. Eligibility is determined by your age and number of years of creditable service.
